ConnectED offers a flexible approach to formal delivery. We have excellent learning facilities at our campuses. These are accessible by train, bus and car and will be in an acceptable distance of each of the employers' premises. Planning for the delivery will be completed jointly, to ensure flexibility whilst making sure employers' staff are well supported and business continuity is not affected. Workshops can also be delivered on-site, should these facilities better suit the needs of the apprentices and employers. We also offer the option of bespoke blended learning inclusive of online training materials relevant to sector delivery. An ePortfolio platform allows 24-hour access to learning resources, tutor contact and a bespoke virtual learning environment. Mentors and managers will be given access to allow them to track and monitor Apprenticeship progress.

Added-value

ConnectED offers value added training to further complement and exceed the requirements of the Apprenticeship standard. This may include the offer of accredited first aid training, attendance at seminars, mental health & wellbeing and relevant health & safety courses*. Should there be any further continued professional development requirements, ConnectED will source and deliver these as part of the planning process. There will also be an opportunity for staff not on the Apprenticeship programme to access guest lectures and attendance at relevant training days. This will be certificated for those staff.

Off the Job Training (OJT)

Off the Job Training is compulsory for every apprentice and this is personalised based on their total number of working hours and model type adopted. There is a minimum requirement for all apprentices to complete at least 20% off the job training. This varies between Apprenticeship standards. The OJT time will be planned with the apprentice's mentor to ensure that there is a wide range of training to cement the learner's knowledge to support achievement. The ConnectED group will provide off the job training at a central location suitable for the apprentice and employer.
